- Organisation of and understanding the freight forwarding company (FIATA MS 1.4)
- Financial requirements for the freight forwarder (FIATA MS 1.5)
- Documents and forms including FIATA documentation (FIATA MS 1.6)
- Transport related geography (FIATA MS 1.6)
- Special transport services including consolidation / groupage, perishables, livestock, plants, project logistics, etc. (FIATA MS 1.7)
- Air, sea, rail, road cargo handling / packing requirements (FIATA MS 1.8)
- Introduction to dangerous goods (FIATA MS 12.1 to 12.6)
- Introduction to Logistics (FIATA MS 10)
