IFP 2: The Freight Science Practitioner

Why this course?

Fully aligned with the FIATA Minimum Standards, the IFP2 builds on the skills of the IFP1 and in addition includes the “gap” modules of the FIATA Diploma. Cross border movement, on which there is a critical skills shortage, is also included in IFP2.

This course covers inter alia the following topics:

- Safety and security (FIATA MS: 13.1 TO 13.4)
- ICT in forwarding (FIATA MS: 14.1 to 14.12)
- Sea transport (general) (FIATA MS: 2.1 to 2.6)
- Maritime containers (sea) (FIATA MS: 3.1 to 3.6)
- Multi-modal transport (FIATA MS: 4.1 to 4.7)
- Air transport (FIATA MS: 5.1 to 5.5)
- Cross border movement and general rail / road transport (FIATA MS: 6.1 to 6.5 and 7.1 to 7.5)
- National / international carriage by inland waterway (FIATA MS: 8.1 TO 8.5)
- Cargo insurance (FIATA MS: 11.1 TO 11.2)

Entry Requirements: Enrolment is open to students who have successfully completed the International Forwarding Part 1 course.

Duration: Correspondence; 8 months with two assignments and two workshops. 1st Semester March and 2nd Semester October.

Investment: R8 900 (Excl. VAT)

SDS Certification: Students who successfully complete the SDS final examinations will receive the industry respected IFP 2: The Freight Science Practitioner Certificate of Competence.

Unit Standard and Assessment Information (Not included in course price):

Students who wish to continue with the assessment/moderation process for the issuance of NQF credits through the Transport Education and Training Authority, have the option to indicate this on the enrolment form. Such students will be contacted by our assessors who will take the assessment and moderation process forward. The skills acquired on this course (after assessment and moderation is completed) contribute 34 credits towards the National Certificate in Freight Forwarding & Customs Compliance (NQF 3) and therefore also contributes towards the achievement of the FIATA Diploma.
